Bio.be was founded on January 23, 2006 as a result of the merger of the Belgian Bioindustries Association (BBA) and BelgoBiotech.

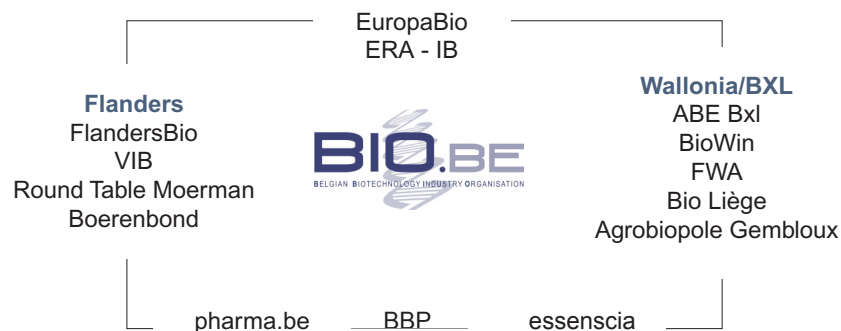

Fees

Bio.be membership fees are set on the basis of the number of staff of the Belgian legal entity which is member. For the purpose of this calculation, "staff" includes all regular employees as well as additional resources (e.g. consultants, management contracts, etc.).

Corporate members

Category 1	Corporate members with a staff of over 250	3.600 €
Category 2	Corporate members with a staff of less than 250	1.800 €
Category 3	Corporate members with a staff of less than 50	900 €
Category 4	Start-up companies (staff of less than 5 and max 2 years since establishment)	450 €

Associate members

Category 5	Associate members - University Interfaces and entities with a staff of less than 50	1.000 €
Category 6	Associate members - all others	2.500 €
